Pope Leo XIV canonized 7 new saints

Among the celebrated lineup of figures were: Ignatius Shoukrallah Maloyan, (April 8, 1869 – June 11, 1915), was an Armenian Catholic prelate who served as Archbishop of Mardin from 1911 to 1915. After repeatedly refusing conversion to Islam, he was tortured and murdered by the Ottoman Gendarmerie during the Armenian genocide. Bishop Maloyan was beatified by Pope John Paul II as a martyr in 2001. In 2025, Pope Francis approved a plan for his canonization.



Former Satanic priest Bartolo Longo, an Italian

lawyer who found his way back to Catholicism and even helped found the Pontifical Shrine of the Blessed Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii.

Longo, who died in 1926 at 85 years old, first deviated from the Catholic Church after losing his mother early in life.

Pope approves beatification for priests martyred under Nazism and Communism

Pope Leo XIV approves the upcoming beatification of nine Polish priests martyred at Dachau and Auschwitz; and two diocesan priests killed out of "hatred of the faith" by the Communist regime that ruled Czechoslovakia in the 1950s. The Holy Father also promulgates decrees concerning four new Venerables: a Spanish Cistercian nun, a Spanish Dominican priest, an Italian diocesan priest, and an Italian Carmelite friar.
