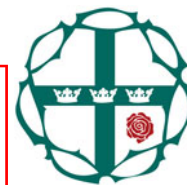

In Matthew 16:16, Peter confessed Jesus that He is the Messiah, the Son of the living God.

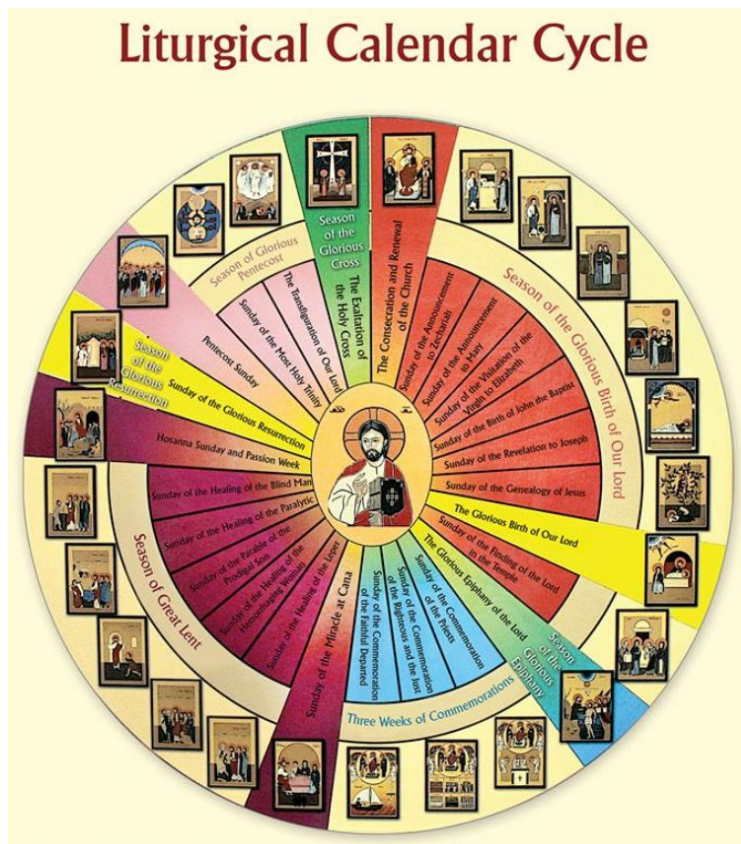
Consecration of the Church is the consecration of the living stones of the church, The Mystical Body of Jesus Christ.

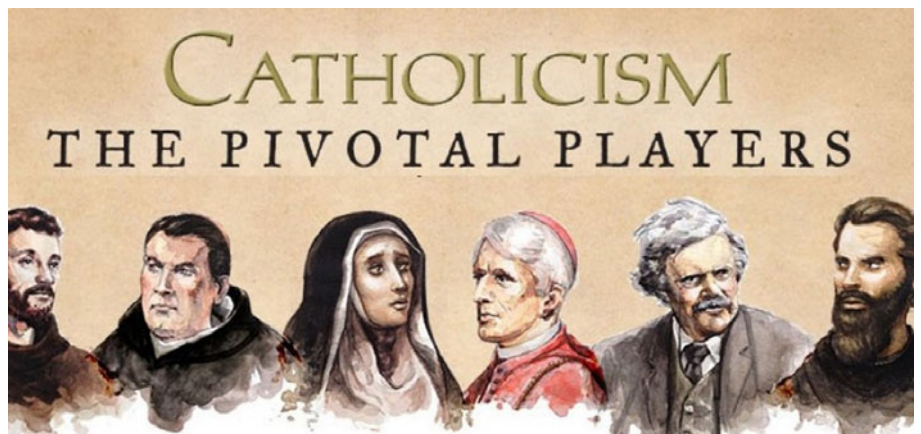
